

Signage Server Manual

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Definitions

- **Player:** A digital signage player with Signage Software that is capable of playing various types of media.
- **Types of Players:** Signage Software supports different types of players. These are
 - Linux • Plays different types of images, videos, live feeds. Audio can be enabled for this player. It can also play mute video and a separate audio playlist.
 - Linux Multichannel • Plays only audio files. Outputs up to 6 mono songs.
 - Android Audio • Plays 1 channel of songs on Android devices.
 - Android Video • Shows different types of images, videos, tickers, document and webpages. Audio can also be enabled for this player. It can also play muted video and separate audio playlist.
 - Windows Audio • Plays 1 channel of songs on windows machines.
- **Types of Users:** Signage software supports different types of users. These are
 - Super User • There will typically be a single superuser for an installation. The Superuser is useful only for installation, initial configuration and registration of licenses etc.
 - Administrator • This profile user can do anything to the players and users allotted to the organization. Administrator access should be managed carefully to ensure that you maintain control over your data.
An organization will typically have only a few administrators.
 - Manager • This profile user is capable of viewing status of players, changing playlist of players, create more users of type viewer and service staff, changing layout of players, creating more layouts, generating reports etc. This profile user will be responsible for day to day management of players.
 - Viewer • A viewer can only view the status of players assigned to them. This includes viewing of screen shot, logs, details of player etc. They will not be able to make any changes to the players.
 - Service Staff • Users with this profile can view the status of players that they are assigned to. They will also be able to fill out service reports for the sites that they visit. To be able to update players having network issues, they will be able to download offline data from the server and update the player with a pen drive.
- **Play Timings:** Timings for which the digital signage player is supposed to be playing media.
- **Layout:** The layout of the screen defines the zones that the screen will be showing. Layout does not apply to audio only players.
- **Resolution:** For displays resolution is the number of pixels that the display is capable of showing.

- **Offline Days:** Number of days for which player will download media playlist from server in advance and will play accordingly even if player is offline.
- **Public IP:** If the ip address assigned to the player is directly accessible by the server, this setting should be True. If the player is behind a NAT/Firewall, and the ip address is not directly accessible this setting should be False.
- **Reboot Time:** It is a particular time in a day when player will go for automatic reboot.
- **Media Type:** Types of media that player will play e.g. video, audio, image, documents.
- **Orientation:** Display orientation of the screen i.e horizontal or vertical.
- **Groups(Players):** set of players.
- **Tags(Media):** We can group multiple media together by giving them a tag.
- **Default Playlist:** When playing schedule is not present for player but default playlist is present then player will play it.
- **Remote Ticker:** Gets ticker content from remote source.
- **Custom Ticker:** Gets ticker content which is created by you manually.


Creating Players

Advance Information:

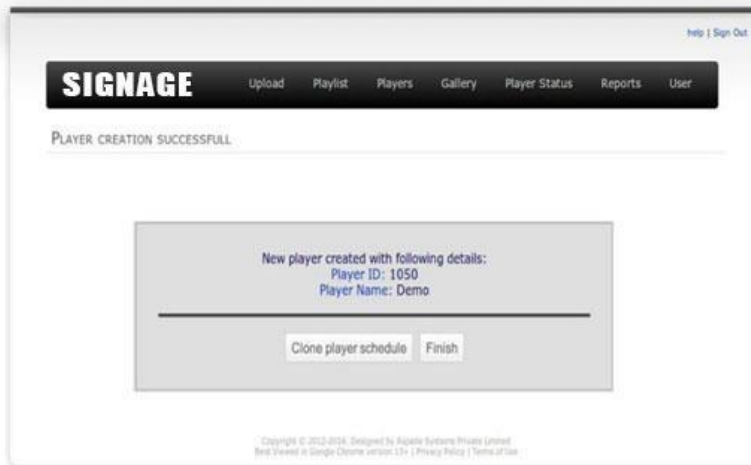
Player type: It defines the 'type of device' your newly created player will run.

Screen Resolution: Select the screen resolution user wants for the new player **Orientation:**Select the orientation of the device on which new player will play. This is only applicable to Android Video, and Linux players.

Reboot:Reboot time defines the time at which the player will restart

Offline days:It defines the number of days playlist player will download so that in case the player is not online it is capable of playing till that number of offline days.

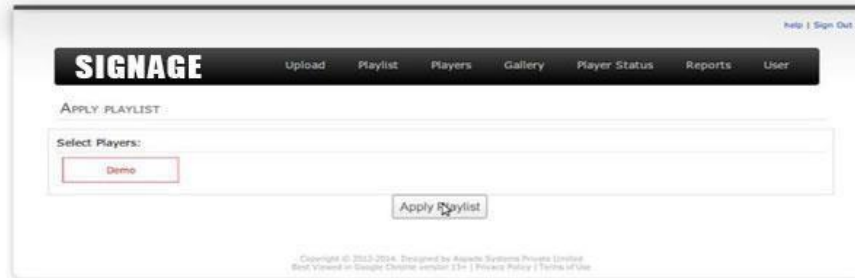
3. After click on create player will take user to `player created successfully`

Apply playlist will apply a selected players playlist



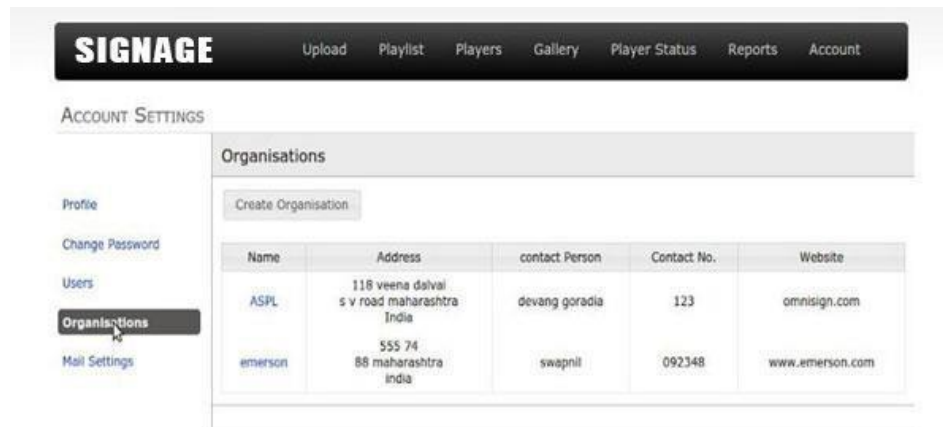
Finish

On click of *finish* it will simply create player but will not have any slot and playlist.


Creating Organization:

Click on Create Organisation Button and Enter the following details mark in astrick (*) and clickon Save Changes Button.



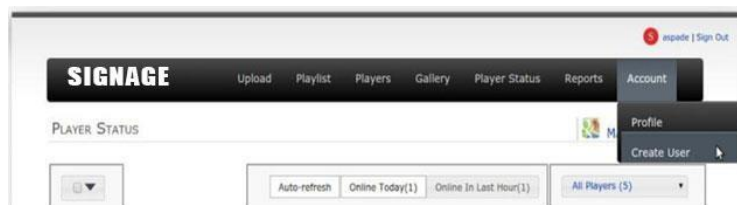

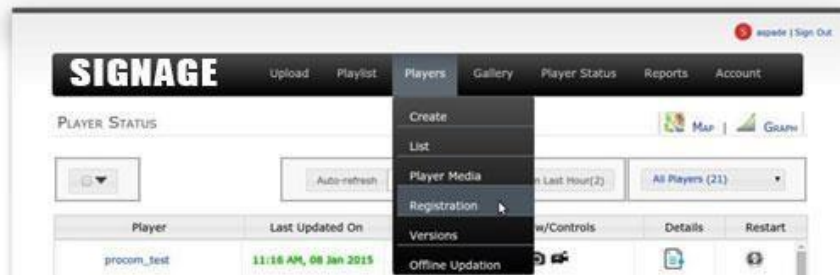
Select the players in the 'Managed Players' to be managed by the user.

- If the Player is registering for first time the key will get generated automatically on the page. **Live Key:**Status column will show green color and 6 digit key will get generated in key|Registration column. This key should be used to register the player on the server.

Registered Player:This will show that player is already registered

Inactive Player:This will show that the player is not registered.

Expired Key: This key cannot be used to register the player.

Note: The reset button on the right side of the page can be used to reset the key, when the key is expired or want to re-register the player on the server.



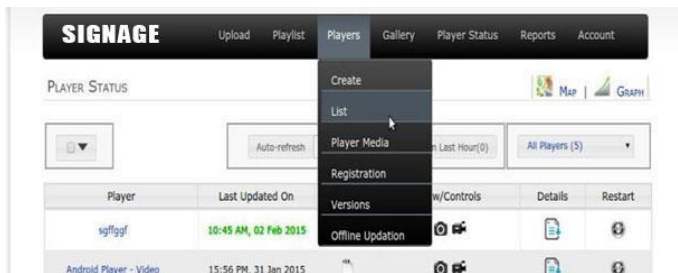
Enter the name of the group which you want to define and click on Add New Group, Group will get create. Click on the checkbox of the created group and click on Save Changes. The player will be added to that group.

Adding new player to existing Group:

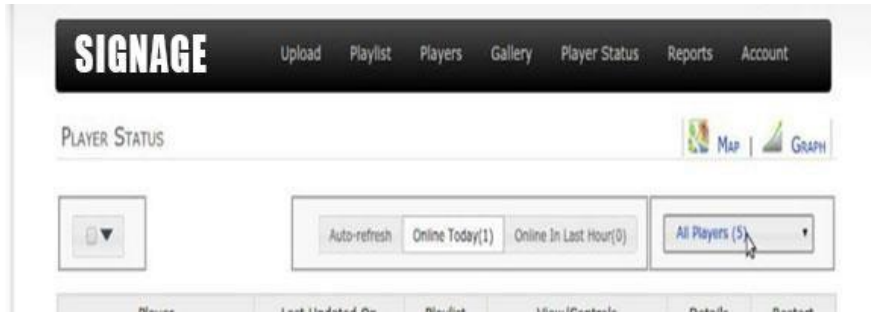
Go to players on the top menu and click on List.

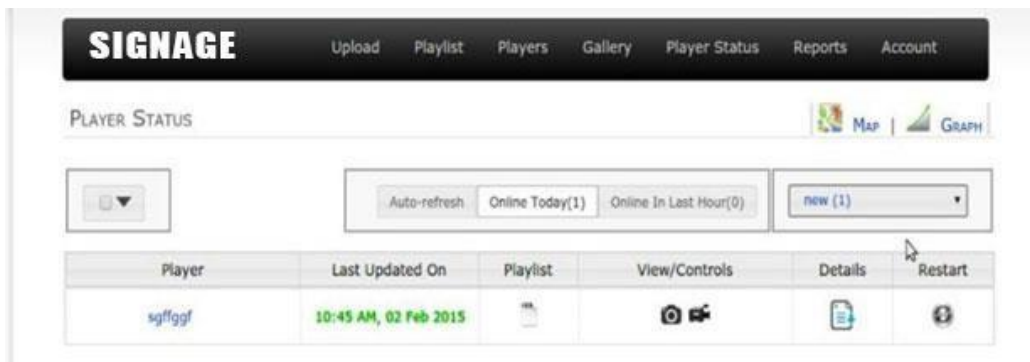


Checking the player in the group:

Goto player status page and on right side of the page click on All player and click on the Created group.



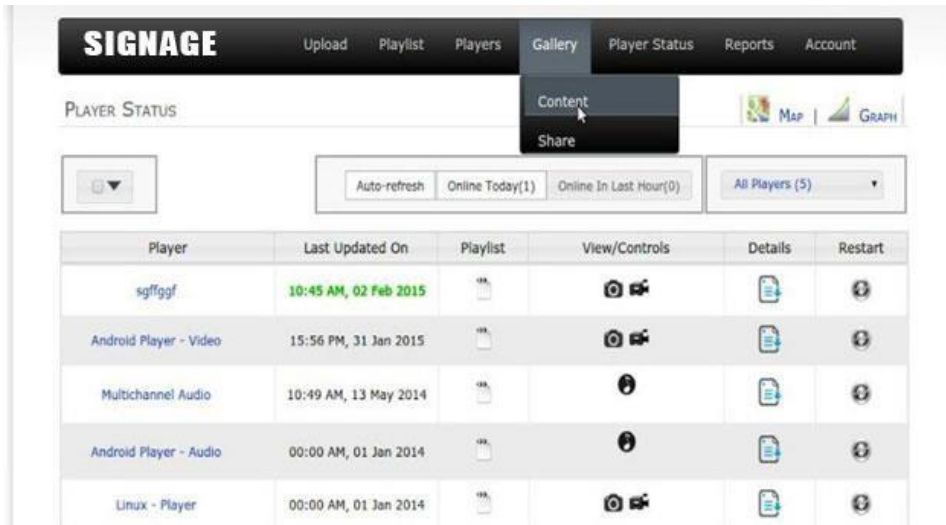
When clicked on created group the player status page will show only those player which are assigned to that group.



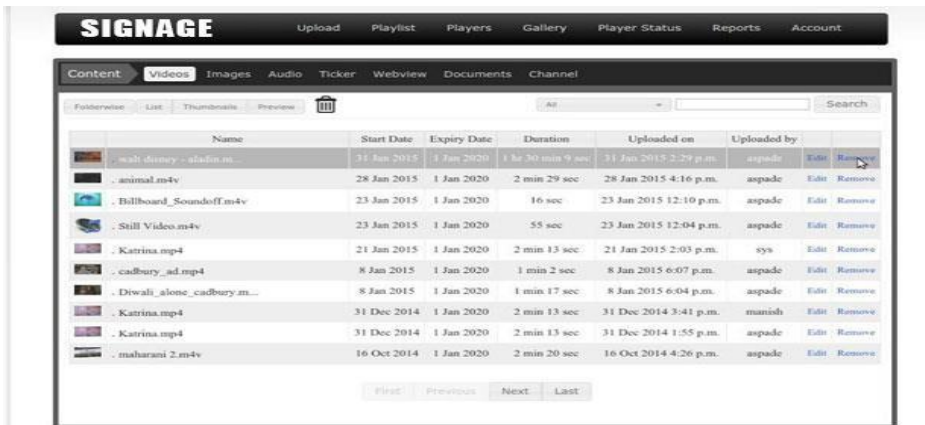
(For Example: Group new has only one player assigned.)

Looping: This option is used when the player is playing more than one slot of different component. (eg. 1 slot contains simple media and 2 slot contains media ticker component.)

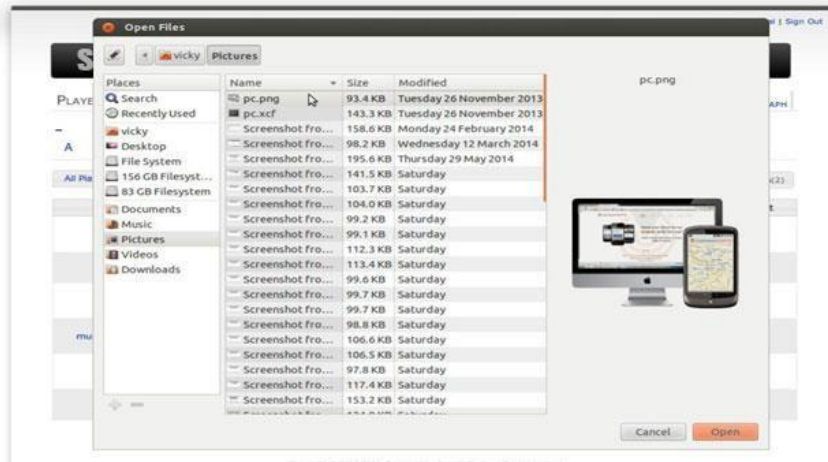

Note: If the media uploaded is a video, click on videos in content, similarly for the audio, image, ticker, web view, document.

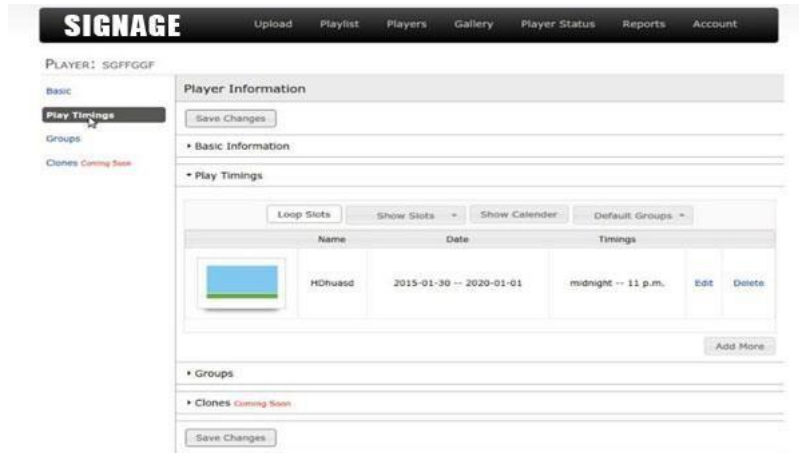

Looping can be configured as follows.

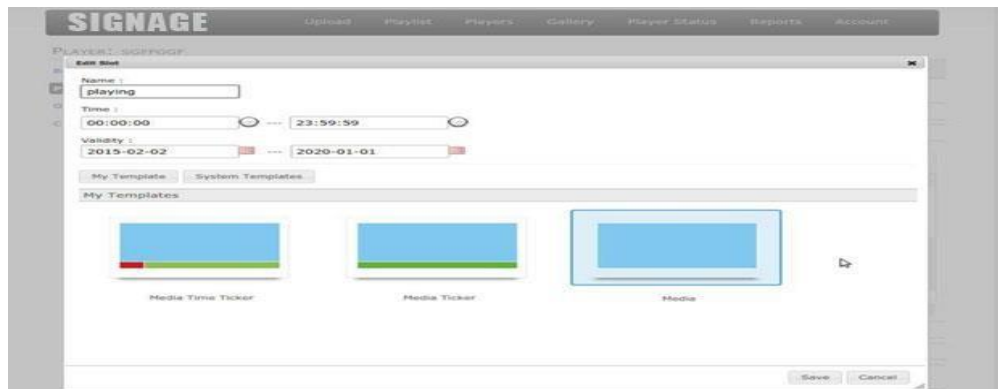

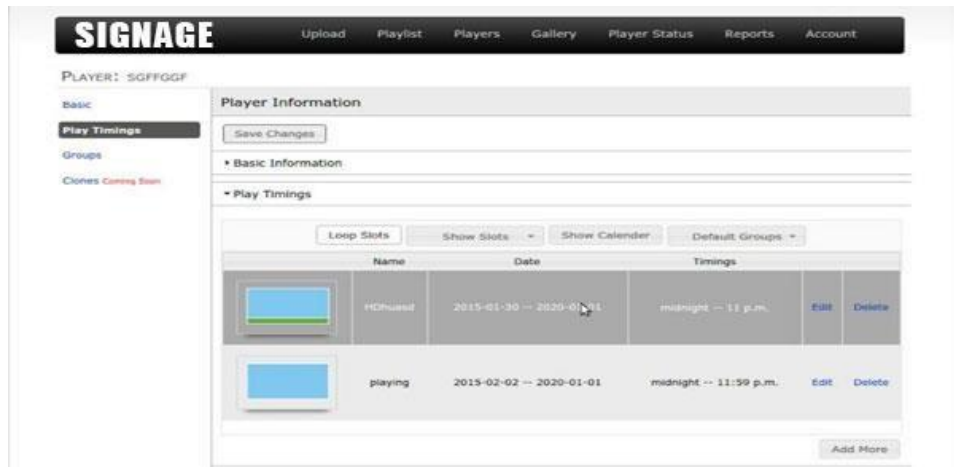


Add Two slot in Play Timings if you want looping playing. To add slot click on add more button to add next slot.

When clicked on Add More following page open. Add The timing and date. Select the template and click on save.



After Click on save button you will see two slot in the Playing Timings as follows.



Note : Date of both slot should be same, user should define the timing of the slot as (1st slot 00:00:00 to 00:10:00) and (2nd slot 00:10:00 to 00:20:00). this will play each slot for 10 min and will loop one after the other. To loop the slot the Loop Slots option should be enabled.



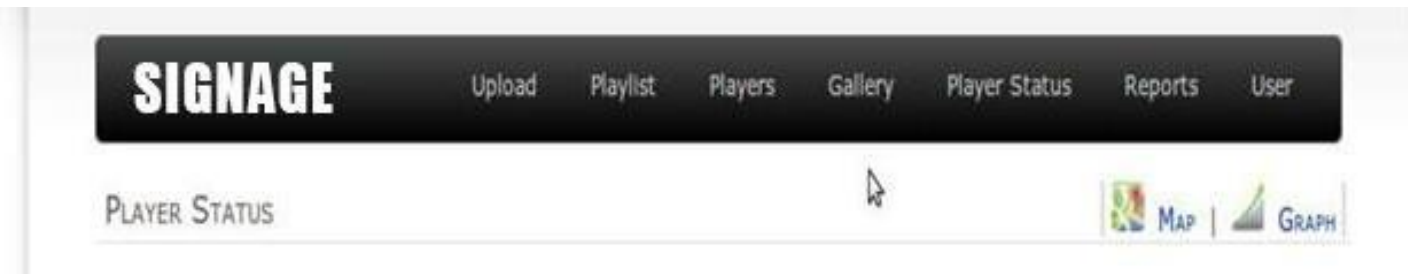
